




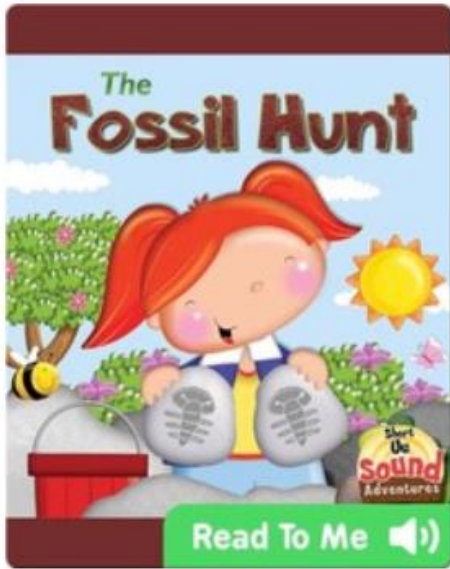

S E S S I O N 1	<p>COMPREHENSION</p> <p>This week, we are looking into Cornwall's mining history! YOU WILL NEED HELP WITH THIS ACTIVITY.</p>  <p>This is Ding, Dong Mine, the oldest tin mining site in Cornwall. It is in Penwith, near to Penzance and looks over St Michael's Mount (where the giant Cormorant supposedly built). Did you know that it wasn't just men that had to go mining? You would have had to as well! <i>What do you think life was like in a mine?</i> Watch this clip to see what life was like for a child miner. 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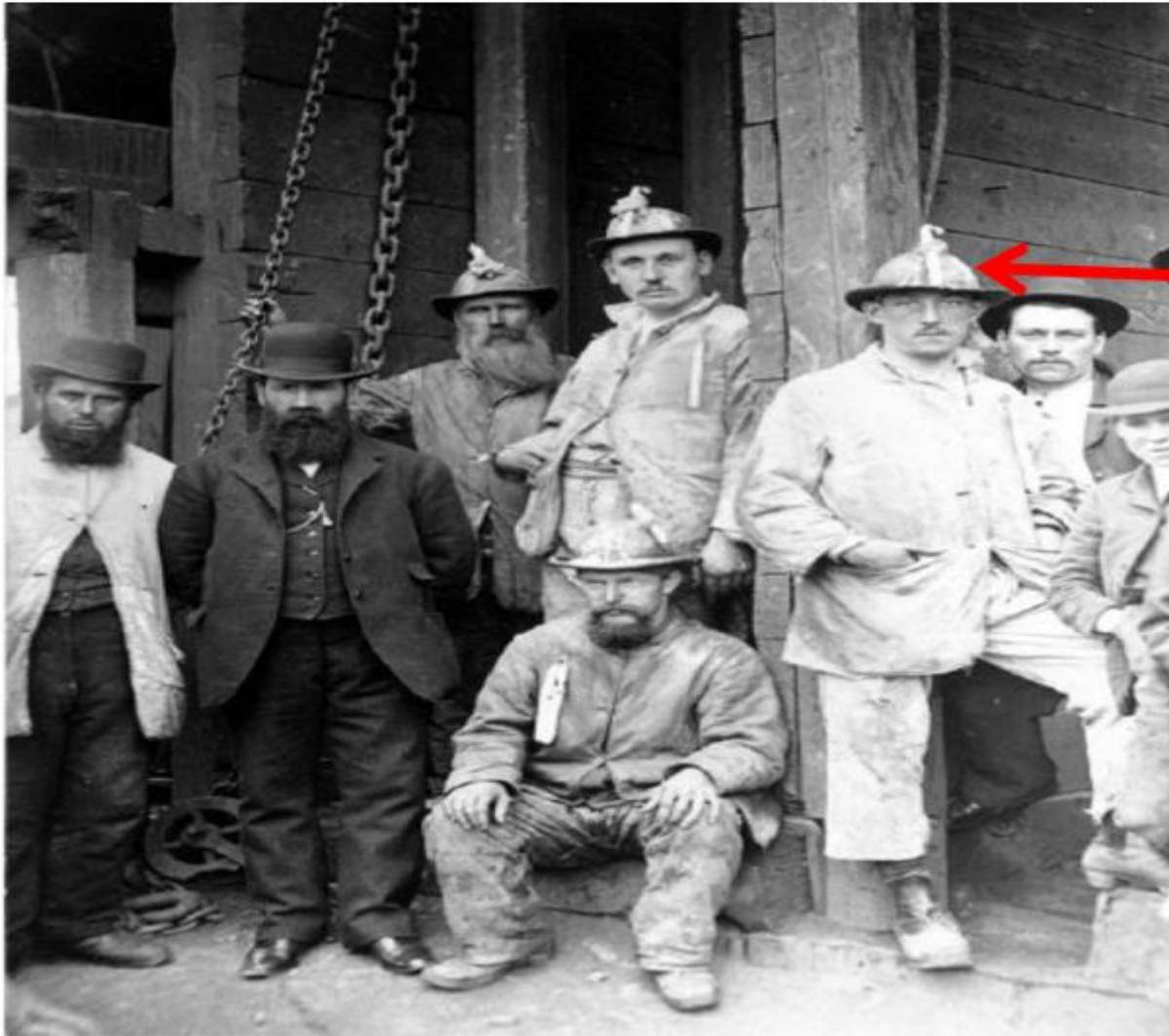

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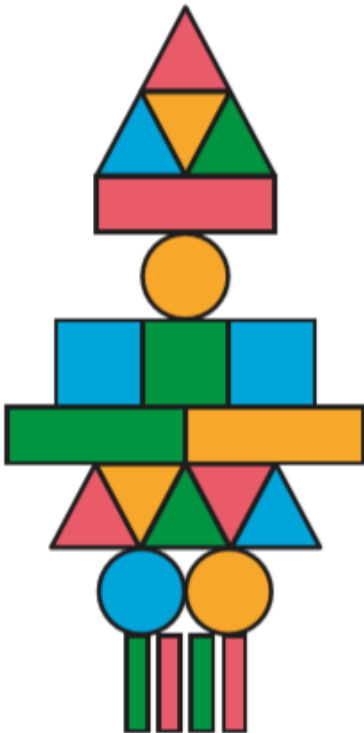

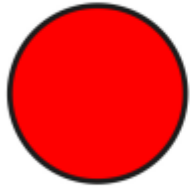
